THE BOARD OF KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL STRONGLY SUGGESTS THAT THE COST OF THE INTERNATIONAL KEY CLUB CONVENTION BE SHARED BY THE KEY CLUBBERS, THE KEY CLUB AND THE SPONSORING KIWANIS CLUB, EACH PAYING ONE THIRD OF THE COST.

- All attendees are encouraged to be fully vaccinated as defined by the CDC. "Fully vaccinated" means "I have received my complete vaccine regimen (2 shots for Pfizer, Moderna or AstraZeneca, or 1 shot for Johnson and Johnson), and 14 days or more has passed since my final shot." Attendees may also attend if they have tested for COVID-19 and received a negative test result within 5 days of the first day that the attendee will be attending meetings. These guidelines may change depending on updated CDC guidelines and/or local ordinances.

- All Kiwanis International member chaperones and guest chaperones attending the 2022 Key Club International Convention must comply with our Youth Protection Policy and Procedures. This includes having a valid enhanced background check (must not expire before July 11, 2022), completed youth protection chaperone training and personal references on file with Kiwanis International by June 13, 2022, prior to arrival at the convention through July 10, 2022. All adults, including guests, staying in the convention hotel are required to have a valid enhanced background check.
